How to speak French:

Say in French: my name is:

Mon nom est

Say: have a nice day:

Ayez un beau jour:

You may find it difficult to pronounce the language easily, and mostly this is because you have to learn that particular speech in French focuses on dialogue.

How to understand French dialogues:

If you were to say in French, "Robert meets his teacher," relating in French you would say "Bonjour, monsieur" which is Robert. Instead of saying to

meet with Robert's teacher however, the name of the professor is the French way to announce the meeting. Thus, Robert would say, "Le professeur," which means Granger in this case. Now if Robert wants to make a comment, he would say in French, "allez-vous."

French's words change in many instances. For instance, the sound that "a" applies in English would apply in French as "front a." Depends on how which sentence or word you would use. For instance, the front 'a' applies in antérieur, which in French means former.

How to produce front a sound in French:

Your mouth would need to be "slightly open" to produce this sound. You will need to draw the corner of your mouth backward and then taut so that the tips of your tongue is against the low area of the "front teeth."

When using French language and pronouncing "u" you have to take a few measures to say what you mean. The letter 'u' in French is like saying 'I' lower case in English. You would need to pucker your lips to pronounce correctly and then say 'u' as if you are whistling. The tip of your tongue should also be against the low area of your teeth at the front.

The consonne 'c' is used in several ways also. For instance, to say canal you would focus on c plus a. When saying cinq the q in this instance is final. Avec is pronounced with the c being final while culture is pronounced with front "c + u." Learning French is fun, so take time to learn more. Bon près for now, or good-bye in English:

Foreign Language Training for French

French is a fun language to learn. The consonne or consonants change in the language, which you have to adjust the mouth to fit the style of speaking French. To help you relate to the details in learning French we can help you understand a few specifics. If you intend to buy programs, CDs, DVDs, audiovisual, or attend foreign language training courses, then having a head start is an advantage.

How to speak French fluently:

Speaking French fluently is easy when you understand a few details. Some French words have the same 'c' sound when using a series of words. For instance, the words: cinq, canal, compte, culture, avec, cruel, quatre have the same 'c' sound. Some of the words however have the 'qu' while others have the

c + a effect.

Now if you were to take the word garçon, which is translated in the same manner and spelled the same way in English, you would apply the sound to: civil, class, statue, excursion, Sept." and so on. To say célèbre you would apply c + e. If you would to pronounce civil you would say c + i, which is pronounced the same way in English.

Regardless, each word above has the double 'ss' sound at the end of the word. The syllables have to contain vowels. In French languages, the syllable usually starts with a consonne, or consonant in English, yet can start

with a vowel too. When using a sole consonant amidst dual vowels in French language, the first vowel usually follows the second vowel.

French relies on accents in some instances. Accents are the marks you see above or below a word, such as célèbre or garçon. In French, some words with 'e's' and marks over them are relative to French acute accents. In this instance, 'e' is the only focus. For example, café, général is an example of acute accents, or as they say in French, l' accent, or accent aigu. Now, in some instances where as grave accents apply the 'e' and marks is often used with the consonne 'e,' yet on many occasions the consonne a and/or u applies. For instance, très, modèle or poète in some instances a or u or both would apply.

In some instances however, l' accent circumflexes or circumflex accent apply. Theatre for instance, in French is pronounced théâtre.

At what time la cédille is applied or, cedilla, thus the 'e' has a double 's' at the ending almost in all instances.

Now let's practice:

We are going to pronounce a few words and divide them into French syllables. Take locomotive for instance, to divide syllables we would say, locomotiva. Notice the 'e' is dropped and an 'a' replaces it. Now say opera. The difference when saying opera in French is noted with the mark above the 'o,' ópera.

Now let's do some contrast words that starts or begins with 'co' and 'ca.' comment for example is commentaire.

As you see this is where contrasts should be compared carefully. Instead of dropping comment as a complete word, the French add “aire” to mean the same thing, using contrast ‘co.’ capable is spelled the same way in French and English, only ‘ca’ is applied in French language.

Now that you have a brief detail of how some of the steps in French language works, you are off to a great start to finding courses, or programs to help you learn how to speak fluent French languages. Learning French Nouns in Foreign Language Training

Getting going:

Frenchmen use nouns in a way that they are gender categorized. In some instances, the nouns are male masculine, while in other instances the nouns are feminine. Using 'un' in French words for example in a masculine way, per se, professeur, which means "a teacher." Using 'un' changes in feminine gender, which 'e' is added at the end. Thus, 'une' for instance 'a window would be interpreted as, une fenêtre. In French 'une' is known as l'article indéfini, or "the indefinite article." In some instances, male and female nouns stand out. For instance, une élève is the same as un élève, which means a pupil.

How cognates apply in foreign language training:

In many instances, cognates apply. That is, this area you want to look for when training to learn foreign languages, such as French. Cognate's simple means that in most instances French and English words resemble each other in many instances. For instance, November in French is pronounced

Novembre, whereas September is Septembre. The 'r' is exchanged. In simple terms, mot apparentès or words apparent is something you want to associate with, since it will make French easier to learn.

Some of the following words are the same as in French as in English.

Opinion: guide: melon: village: film: image: dialogue:

Applying 'a' in foreign language training:

In some instances, front 'a' applies, yet in other instances back 'a' applies to words spoken in French. For example, if you took the keyword encore or bis, the vowel nasalisee in or in French voyelle nasalisée en could conclude many meanings. In some instances, ah is added at the end of French words. Phrases, such as classe, use back 'a' or a postérieur, which ah brings out its meaning.

Now ask me how 'an' works in French, or demandez (ask) me how 'an' changes in French languages. The phrases that apply 'an' or 'en' uses the a postérieur solution, which you must pronounce the words with air passing through the nostrils.

Air should partially pass on through the mouth too. What happens is the nasal effect, which vowels apply in French. In summary, whether you are phrases encore or words with an, the patterns does not change in most instances as to how you say it.

The best way to learn French is to use the divide syllables instructions, which you can break down the phrases easier.

When learning French take your time to study a few patterns in the language. Study and learn how it applies to each phrase spoken, which in time you will learn to say complete sentences in French. If you are not interested in French, go online and check out other languages available to you, such as Dutch, German, and Irish and so on. The Fun of Foreign Training in German Language

Like learning any foreign language, vowels, consonants, nouns, etc change slightly in some instances. If you plan to visit a foreign country, it is nice to know precise languages to speak with natives in that land. Using some language incorrectly can land you in a world you wished you had never visited. You can offend people in foreign countries by attempting to speak their language with no learning backing you. In fact, you are better off acting like you are struggling to hear what they are saying to you, rather than attempting to speak the language when you do not know what you are saying.

Therefore, those of you off to Germany, take some time to study some of the language so that you know what you are doing when you visit. What to do:

Take a venture into our German training exercises for a moment.

To begin we want to discuss the common mistakes, so that you can avoid them especially if you are visiting Germany. Some of the common mistakes are that people forget to use stem vowels in 2nd and 3rd person singulars of stronger verbs that are stated in present tense. For instance, if you are to say, “You are falling” in German, the common mistake should be avoided which is Du fallst. You would say Du fällst or Sie fallen. If you were to say, “he fell,” you would say er fiel. You don’t want to say Er fallite. The form of language where “du” is applied in the language is where many people are confused.

When using strong verbs, avoid using weaker verbs when past tense statements are made, use the example he fell to see how the mistakes could easily be misleading. To avoid this mistakes, you want to learn by rote the stronger verbs, especially when the verbs are used in past tense. Sometimes the mistakes when speaking German is that people tend to use strong verbs wisely when past tense applies, yet the person will end with a weak note. He fell is the same example you can follow to say the past-tense statement correctly.

Sometimes people end sentences with present tense whereas past tense applies to strong verbs. For instance, “I came” may be stated as “ich kame,” which is incorrect. The correct way to say I came is Ich kam. You want to learn the past and present tense verbs in German to relate better to this understanding. For example, some of the simple past tense verbs are ich, which is commonly used in Germany, du in durftest, Sie, as in durften, wir as in durfte, ihr, durftet, and so on. Present tense changes, where as ich is darf instead of durfte as in past tense.

Some other common mistakes are that people forget to use stem in mixed verbs or past tense. For instance, “the runner ran fast.” Some people may say *Der läufer rennet schnell* whereas the correct way to say the same thing is *der Läufer lief schnell*. Notice how the marks change the meaning.

When using *modale Verben* or modal verbs the present tense in usual fashion should be avoided. For instance, if you are to say “He cannot come” then you would say *Er kann nicht kommen* instead of *Er kannt nicht kommen*. See that in the first instance the ‘t’ is dropped in *kann*.

Diacritic rules apply, or accent marks apply when plurals form in present tense. That is, in some instances you want to recognize that modals have diacritic forms. For instance, if you were to say, “we are supposed to come” to Germany, you would say *wir sollen kommen* “we are supposed to come,” or *wir sollen nach Deutschland kommen* meaning we are supposed to come to Germany. You want to avoid saying *Wir sellen kommen*.

When changing double ‘s’ and B, especially when modal verbs apply you want to use the words carefully, e.g. “he must come,” would be interpreted as this if the speaker says, *er muß kommen*. If the speaker says, *Er muss kommen*, this is a mistake.

Next, learn: *wie Kernwortschatz zutrifft*, or how core vocabulary applies:

How Core Vocabulary Applies in Germany Foreign Language Training

Learning the rules in Fremdsprache-Training, or foreign language training is helpful, especially if you intend to visit Germany. Don't be the one visiting Germany with mistaken communication in speaking foreign language, since some German's will take offense. Learning a new language is always fun, especially when you learn to speak the languages correctly.

In this instance, we can discuss German core vocabularies to help you get the most out of foreign language training.

In German, it is important that the language have strong verbs. Some of the strong verbs used in Germany are fahren – fährt and fuhr. The infinitive outlines 3rd- person singular verbs in the “simply past tense” form. When vowels have stem change, thus this is when the third-person singulars apply. For instance, if you are to say, “to resemble,” in Germany, you would say ähneln and to end you would say beenden. To offer to help someone in Germany you would say, kann ich helfe Ihnen.

How do I learn how to use proper present-tense forms in speaking words with verbs in German. Your best bet is to become familiar with verbs, past tense verbs, simple past tense, present, and so on, as well as the core

vocabulary. You can find guides that offer you instructions for learning German languages, or buy audiovisuals, CDs and so on online that will offer you guides in learning foreign languages, such as German.

For now, we can do a few exercises to test your skills.

Wir, is interpreted in German in some instances, as we. Now if you were to say we come to dinner in prerequisites, with present tense and verb conjugations you would say it as Er Dommt zum abendessen. Wir dommen zum abendessen: Du kommst zum abendessen, or in English It Dommt with dinner: We dommen with dinner. You come with dinner. The proper method to say we come to dinner is, wir kommen zum Abendessen.

To learn to speak German effectively, you will need to learn the basics in the foreign structure. Having an explanation can help.

How to interpret German elements:

Grammar for instance, in Germany is separated into smaller units and managed in a way that it correlates. To learn German effectively you will need to learn the divisions in the language and then learn the core vocabulary, take short lessons and answer questions when applied. Durch, or through: We seen durch the American’s den cried for help, and des the many we could not help.

Now if you were to continue learning the basics, you could in time, put a complete sentence in German together so that any German native could relate.

Verb Stem Forms in German Language Learned in Foreign Training

Yet if you want to say 'made' you would say machte. These are weak verbs however. Strong verbs is commonly used in Germany, which if you were to say verb stems such as 'kommen' or to come, you would use a strong verb. To same "came" in German you would say kam, which is also a strong verb.

The weaker verbs, such as machen or arbeiten, i.e. to work are something to consider when learning foreign languages. To help you relate to simple past tense and present verbs we can review singular and plural verbs used in order.

The popular singular words used in Germany incorrectly by non-natives is "ich, du, er, sie, es." To use the words in present tense you would apply the verbs to Ich Mache or arbeite whereas if you use simple past tense you would apply 'te,' e.g. ich machte or arbeitete. As you can see, you merely add the 'te' to the end of each word when you want past tense.

In plural form, the common German words are ‘wir, ihr, sie and Sie.’ If you use the words in present tense you would say wir machen, yet to say the sentence in past tense you would say, wir machten.

The stronger verbs used in Germany also uses common words, such as ich and wir. For instance, if you wanted to say in singular present tense, ich fahre or lese then you would not apply the simple past tense. On the other hand, if you wanted to say ich fuhr or las in German, using the simple past tense in singular terms, thus you would use strong verbs either way. In plural terms, you would say wir fahren or lesen and in simple past tense, you would say wir fuhren or lasen. Notice the differences between the way the words are used in plural and singular form.

You want to consider when using present tense verbs where strong verbs apply that in some instances the vowels within the stems of “infinitive change” will alter the vowels. The alteration will affect the language, changing it to ‘second and third person’ singulars.

For example, using the word fahren you will notice that the a in singular form changes to ä in second or third person form. When using more than one verb, au changes to äu. For instance, to say, “To run” you would say laufen, yet if you change the verb, you would apply the marks. Now say I to strike. You probably cannot say this at this point, but if you wanted to use strong

verbs in present and past tense you would either say, “Ich StoBe” or in past tense wir stoBen. To say the same thing in plural, you’d apply wir instead of ich and add the n. Now discover the special conjugations in German verbs.

Special Conjugations in Foreign German Language Verbs for Training

The special conjugations in German verbs stand out, since it makes pronunciation easier. You can especially learn easier when you apply certain rules in German language, such as applying –d or –t and inserting an –e prior to the verbs ending. If an –e is already in the ending, then forget the last remark.

How German verb stem endings apply to the rules of learning:

With German verb endings, some of the same rules apply. For instance, when speaking present tense or past tense in some areas –m or –n rules apply. The verb stem endings when –d applies as well should be considered carefully. For instance, melden means to report. Applying –m to breathe you would say atmen. Applying –n to arrange or order you would add the –n at the ending, and say ordnen.

German's use *ich* often in their language, which means 'I.' With present tense the verb stem ending applies to say to report, whereas *ich melden*.

The Verbs spoken in German applies to:

Some of the weak verbs spoken in German language apply present and simple past tense verb stem endings also. To make German language easier to learn, you can add *-e* to the ending of verbs that end with *-m* or *-n*. You can sound out the words and let them guide you to where you would insert an *-e*.

In some instances, verbs can have irregular second/third person singulars, especially when present tense is involved. For instance, to say, "To hold" you would use strong verbs that have irregular singulars and say *halten*. To load you would say *laden*. And if you want 'to advise', you would say *raten*. The verbs used in this example are strong, yet they have stem-vowels that change the direct communication. For example, *ich halte* means "I hold." *Ich lade* and *ich rate* means I load and I guess/advise. As you can see, the meaning can change, since stem-vowels change the way you relate.

In some cases, verb endings whereas *-eln* is used the *-e* is dropped in the first-person, present tense singular way of expressing what you mean. Some verbs have infinitive endings however. For example, the verbs *-n* applied: *Tun* or to do, have a strong verb infinitive. You can study the conjugations however to compare. The conjugation words in German may start with 'I' or *ich tue*, which is present or *wir tun*, which means we to do, is also a link to the strong verbs.

When verb stems end with –s sounds, i.e. –s, ss, - B, or –z, thus –du forms add a –t within the “present tense of all verbs” whether they be weak or strong. Inserts, such as –e make it easier to pronounce in most instances, especially when added to simple past tense verb stem endings. This will make the verb strong. If you want to create weak verbs then add –test to the verb stem ending.

For example, reisen, which means to travel is a strong verb, while sitzen, means to sit is a weak verb.

Often people press themselves or others to study harder, although we may study ten hours each week on a single lesson. We often press ourselves to organize our thoughts, review our memory cautiously etc. We do these things to stimulate our ability to perform successfully to reach our peak performance. We often adhere to the beliefs that excellent study habits will pay us great rewards. In short, we believe that our efforts will reap benefits such as improved memory.

Often when we fail, we see that all of us at one time take our memory bank for granted. One of the most common problems people face, is when taking exams they will often forget answers to certain questions and will recall the answers once the pressure is taken off them. Many of us acquire a stubborn; unreasonable behavior, which promotes our willfulness to continue doing something we know, is wrong.

One of the best guides in abolishing old or bad habits is to learn the concepts of learning. Moreover, what it means to you. The learning process is perceived within us as we often explore our own behaviors. We often have to rule out aspects our person however to discover effective abilities that help us to learn, even foreign languages. Since, drugs, alcoholism, growth, maturation, fatigue, growth, etc all play a role in the concepts on learning, we want to deduce that factoring these elements into our learning processes can help us to see what we need to change to learn faster.

We must observe closely ourselves. In addition, we must observe closely what we learn to learn effectively and retain information easier. We must use our reasoning process (inference) to force logic thinking to the processes or reasoning from premise or basis to conclusions. We draw conclusions based on evidence or our own reasoning.

What you should know:

We learn easier and effectively when taught directly. When objects are indirect, it confuses the mind. We must evaluate these objects to see areas that we can improve all areas our lives, especially if you want to learn foreign languages. Indirect objects are mass, energy, forces unseen, maturation, drugs, alcoholism, growth, fatigue, growth, etc. Once we begin to explore the indirect, we will begin to see clearly, what changes we can make that will benefit us in learning foreign languages.

How can we remove indirect objects and replace them with direct concepts in learning?

The first indirect concept that we can explore that will enhance your chances of learning foreign languages, is in fact, foreign languages itself.

What foreign language means to you:

Foreign language is languages spoken from other countries outside of your own and deals with, or involves introductions outside into places where it doesn't belong, such as the human body. Thus, this means it doesn't

associate with a particular thing or person and is often formal or irrelevant.

Note: the keyword “irrelevant” should stick out in your mind. This keyword is a prime focus in improving memory to learn foreign languages, since when you start making things relevant to you, thus you not only increase or improve memory, and you open your mind to learning. Open minds can learn quickly, smoothly and will enjoy foreign language training.

Now learn about concepts of incentives and responses in foreign language training.

The Incentives and Responses in Foreign Language Training

Foreign language training opens room for incentives and responses in the concepts of human learning. In fact, incentives or stimulus and responses are the primary focus that you will center on if you want to learn to learn foreign language.

When our mind and body feels stimulated it is more inspired to learn. We need incentives to keep us going also. Most importantly however, stimulus and responses is a great part of our vocabulary, words and the way we communicate with others.

We often denote stimulus in our physical traits when something in our environment stimulates us. When this stimulus occurs it effects change within energy to our receptors. Our receptors involve our sensitive nerve endings and impulses. When we are stimulated by noises, voices, languages, etc, if

all sends energy to these receptors. We have several aspects of stimulus and responses to consider.

Now we have two stimulus states, which are distinguished amidst functional and nominal. When stimulus target nominal receptors we begin the experimenter, or scientific testing through manipulation phrase, which helps us to decide on discriminating factors between two shapes, languages, etc. For example, if your mind is stimulated by shapes, and if this shape produces a brilliant light and then another light brighter, likely you will respond to the light, rather than the shape itself. In short, you will start to discover whether or not your theories are correct, which determines your course of action. Your functional stimulus will kick in, which shows differences in the way you perceive or hear.

Stimulus is also noted as “stimulus-as-coded.” In summary, when someone shakes their head in disagreement we may perceive the action as either positive or negative, which reflects on the way we respond. This is a reflection of our ability to perceive through manners of image and/or coding the stimulus as we see them. Functional stimulus is instituted in the memory, which our encoders connect.

Our responses vary also. Our molar responses to name one variant effect the way we see a list of words. This is important when learning foreign languages or learning in general, since foreign language has core lists, which is the prime focus in learning effectively.

However, our micro-molar approaches are sufficient, since places great weight on particular quantity properties in the way we learn from responses received.

How are these responses initiated?

Responses are initiated in many ways. One of the prominent and most effective responses is association. This is important. Association connects us to objects, which we become more involved and can organize and work in union with groups.

We develop a relationship through association. Thus, association is amidst stimuli, which channels to an ‘associationistic’ structure that draws from purpose and forms from association amidst the incentives or stimuli.

The S-R (Stimulus-Response) helps us to identify easier, e.g., when we associate a list of foreign words with our own language, it helps us to recall easier. We use the S-R abilities to associate. S-S (Stimulus-Stimulus), which reaches inside the associationistic structures of learning, since it connects us through association, which we establish. Thus, the ability helps us to find deeper meaning in what we learn.

We also learn from practicing, yet we use our symbolic mental process, such as logic, reasoning, abstracting, thinking, memory and organizing to place emphasis on our lessons learned through practice. How we obtain our knowledge from study also plays a huge part in how well we do in foreign language training. In addition, through association we develop skills and knowledge effectively, which also helps us to learn foreign languages easier.

Now that you have the basic structure in retaining memory and learning processes, you can move to learn foreign languages in business.

Business in Foreign Language Training

When it comes to business, it is important to know your nouns, personal pronouns, verbs, descriptive adjectives, adverbs, and so on. When you have down pat the common communication skills in business you are on your way to success.

However, how do common communication skills benefit you in foreign language training?

If you haven't figured this out by now, foreign language also uses nouns, syllables, verbs, etc in their communication. The differences are that verbs, nouns, etc change slightly in some cases and in others dramatically.

Like our language, verbs change when delivered in plural or singular words. In English we change singular by dropping an -s, and when we use plural form we add the -s. In some languages -e, -n, -s -t, etc often replaces the

ending verb stem. Still, we want a basic knowledge in how to identify nouns, verbs, etc.

In German, strong verbs are important. We call these active verbs in our language. In some languages, singular forms with noun or verb stem endings, thus the sounds change. In some languages, such as French the people use nasal sounds to express words, which in our land we use the hissing sounds, which in comparison is similar. We also use present and past tense when speaking.

To help you relate in how do common communication skills benefit you in foreign language training we can review a few changes in the structures of foreign language and English in the business sector.

How the German Language changes patterns in present and past tense verbs:

Here is a list of German words in present and past tense. Commonly, German language uses 'ich' 'wir' 'du,' reise, sitze, reiste, and saB. Take a close look at the words. Don't worry about what it means at this time. If you know what it means, fine, you are advanced. Otherwise, bear with me.

The verb stem form in this language is a mixture of weak (passive verbs) and strong verbs. (active verbs) Reise is an active verb, meaning travel. Sitze is a strong verb meaning sit. Reiste is a weak verb meaning traveled and SAB when translated from German to English means SAB. Notice with the weak verb reiste a -t- was added and with SAB the verb stem ending is capitalized. We see that German's add t- capitals and in some instances -n

instead of –s, which is commonly added to simple past tense verbs in English.

In business language, English or other languages, it is important to know your nouns, pronouns, active and passive verbs, descriptive adjectives, adverbs, and so on. When you know the grammar structure in one language, you will find it easier to learn grammar structure in other languages.

Unlike English language, the capital letters do not usually start at the beginning, rather in some instances the letters are at the ending. German language teaches you the structure in grammar, which in many instances masculine and feminine sounds apply.

You will train to learn neuter, superlative, present and past participle when learning German language. Participle is the form of verbs, which German languages uses to form complex tense words, such as “was.” Adjectives is sometimes used. Yet it is depending on meaning and what the message is relaying to others.

In German training, you learn adjectives in a new way; as well, you learn comparative and superlative ways to communicate and when to apply them. Learning German will help you to relate to deletions in the final meaning. You will learn the endings and rules and how they apply. In addition, you

will learn that fragments in German is not necessary wrong as they are in English.

German language teaches you irregular ways to communicate, and to use comparative and superlatives to decide the present and past participles.

German has some unusual types in expressing languages. In some instances, the communication words send signal in plural form. Unlike English, you will find that many of the rules apply in German language are abolished.

German speakers often use or avoid verb infinitives, yet it depends on what the message sent is relaying and if progressive tense verbs or its meaning has use for infinitives.

In some instances, German languages isolates pronouns, words, fragments, and sometimes replaced with prepositions. Prepositions when used is words put before nouns, or a member of sets of words used in close connection with nouns or before nouns and pronouns to show a relation to other parts of meanings with clauses.

How to prepare in foreign language training for German:

If you are preparing to study and learn German, take time to explore the core list and grammar usage often used in the country.

This will help you to get the most of your training. The core list is essential, since it helps you to relate to a list of words that focus on grammar, verb stem endings and so on.

The Grammar Structure in German for those Training in Foreign Language

Grammar is a widely misinterpreted writing tool. Grammar is the rules of language. The system of grammar rules apply by which words form and string together to make a working sentence. Grammar is particular sets of language rules, which when speaking or writing the language or analysis of these rules are effective based on the writers of these rules guidelines. This is the quality of language, which when spoken or written in the form of language relates to “accepted” standards or correct language. Grammar is a systematic pool of elementary principles outlined by the subjects and interrelationships.

As you can see, grammar is often misunderstood and misinterpreted, since the man or woman that wrote these principles and rules, forget to mention the world of cultures, ethnics, races, and so on. Still, the rules apply, yet the change in various countries.

For instance, in our country verbs is words indicating action or state, showing some meaning that takes place or indicates existence of the state of conditions. It is parts of our language or speech that words belong to, and sometimes these predicates of sentences part clauses to include verbs while excluding subjects of the verb.

The rules of grammar change in some ways when you visit foreign countries and speak their language. Verbs for example in Germany have strong/weak meaning, verb stem endings change, and so on. In English, the words are

weak or strong also, yet we see them as passive and/or active. When we write sentences, which include various aspects of grammar outlined in the rule as wrong, we are said to be wrong, yet in Germany, these rules do not always apply.

Let's review verbs so that we can see how they change in some countries:

German verb interpretation:

English Verb Interpretation:

In English and German dative verbs is a grammatical form, which nouns, pronouns and various other parts of speech indicate indirect objects of verbs used after particular prepositions. Now we use dative verbs everyday in our languages despite which country we live in, yet many of us are unaware of the usage.

Dative verbs outline intransitive and when it follows the German Case System, it changes.

Let's **review:**

The English dative in the structure of grammar is rarely pointed out, which is why most people do not realize what they are using when they speak. Dative verbs is seen in the following example: opposite. So when you say a sentence with opposite embedded in it, you are using dative verbs. However, German points out these dative verbs often, which should also be pointed out in English, yet the English as we know falls far behind true English speaking.

Examples of Dative Verbs:

To answer – translated antworten (German)

To believe – glauben

To meet – begegnen

To help – helfen

To obey – gehorchen

To forgive – verzeihen

To follow – folgen

To thank – danken

To trust – trauen

As you can see, you use these words almost in every sentence in your everyday speech, yet in German language dative verbs is strongly applied and recognized.

In Germany, Genitive verbs are used too. Genitive is now being learnt in America, but is often used in Germany. Possessive grammatical case, which some languages affect nouns, pronouns, adjectives and often indicates a possession. Genitive verbs when applied in German sometimes works prepositions where two-ways apply and colloquial speech is present. We see this in the following example:

Example: Instead of buying a porche, we bought a convertible.

German: Anstatt, ein porche zu kaufen, kauften uns ein Kabriolett.

Can you pick the Genitive verbs? If you said, “Instead of” then you know

your genitive verbs. Next, learn the problems specifically within the German Case System.

Foreign Language Training and the German Case System

Foreign language training in the German Case System

Unlike German, the subject does not always start at the beginning of a sentence. German's however can invert usual word order, starting a sentence with other choice of words.

Example:

English version: Don't want to see this movie, or I don't want to see this movie. Alternatively, I wouldn't want to see this movie.

German: nicht diesen Film sehen, sonst ich möchte nicht diesen Film sehen.
Wechselweise würde ich nicht diesen Film sehen wollen.

Lesson:

Choose the subject in this example: "I" is the subject, whereas the first sentence does not have a noun, so no subject applies.

Now, if you were to invert to place emphasis on a sentence and use the German Case System you would:

Example:

English: I can't stand the taste of this new drink.

German: Ich kann nicht den Geschmack dieses neuen Getränks stehen.

The words, "I can't" has been inverted in this instance, which emphasis is stressed. Sometimes German language creates or inverts words to create links back to prior sentences spoken. "Are you staying in tonight?" "No, tonight I chose to watch a film."

"Tonight acres you staying in?" "NO, tonight I chose ton view A film."

Notice in the sentences some of the German words used are the same as some of the English words pronounced: film, watch, view, staying in, tonight, etc...The purpose of pointing this out, is when you learn foreign languages you want to associate the words with what you know. This will help you learn smoothly and effectively.

It is important to learn these rules when you learn German, as well as when you are speaking German to other fellowmen. Incorrectly speaking can lead to misunderstandings. In some instances, you can recognize inverted words when the sentence does not start with a subject by noticing how the nouns and pronouns reflect on and follow verbs with non-nominative excerpts. This is not always the case. When German languages uses words, such as warden or sein, thus the rule does not apply since it connects to nominative verbs.

Nominative verbs are subject case whereas grammar relates or belongs to the case when used in some languages to elect a noun or pronoun, which functions as the subject of clauses in a sentence.

You want to pay close attention to your training when learning German language. If you were to say what many people say to others in this country, such as “That’s only supposed to be a joke.” or: That’s only supposed tons A joke: or; Das soll nur einen Witz sien.” You could offend a native could-be friend.

NOTE: Now we see why language as we know it, is confusing to some people. Take the latter for example, in our own languages when we say this,

it can offend some, which is clear evidence they have another culture within their bloodstream, and communication is confused.

Das soll nur einen Witz sien.” Explained:

In this instance, Witz is a word that is determined in the language by the following infinitive verb. To say the same sentence correctly, you would say, “Das soll nur ein Witz sein.” “That should be only one joke.”

In some instances, German language isolates the pronouns and changes them to word fragments. When English speakers use this method, thus non-subject form is the common way. (E.g. English: “Who is there? I am there – German- Wer ist dort? Ich bin dort)

Now choose the subject from the example:

Answer: “am there” is the subject in this case.

Now, if you were to say this same sentence and apply colloquial or informal speech, you’d have a much better effect. Since, German languages does not substitute however with informal speech, thus this method is proper: Wer ist dort? Ich bin dort.

When you are learning to speak German, it is always best to say what you want to say in your mind first before speaking. You want to understand the case pronouns. Now, learn the present and past participles as German’s use as adjectives.

Present and Past German Participles in Foreign Language Training

When you are learning a new language, such as German it is wise to pay close attention to what you learn. German language changes often. In English language we not these present participles in the following sentence. “I want a hotel room with “running” water. The word quoted is an example of present participles. English usually translate the present participles with –ing endings. Germans however end forms –d to pronounce the same word: Laufen, means in German “running.” Notice this participle however does not apply the –d to verb infinitives. German’s almost always add adjectives when using present participles.

When learning new languages, such as German it is wise to learn the core vocabulary and words. This will help you to relate to what you learn easier. The core lists will show you examples of adjectives, nouns, verbs, etc.

Here is a list for your convenience, which can get you started in understanding adjectives and nouns:

List:

German: der Feind –e meaning in English Enemy

der Freitag – e meaning Friday in English

hoch – means high in English

die Katze –n or cat

die Fassung –en or version

das Fieber or fever

This is a basic list of german, core vocabulary where adjectives are used. Notice in the areas where capitalization applies. Look at the –er or –e to help you pronounce the words correctly.

You have so much to learn when learning foreign languages. Take your time

and explore the language you wish to learn, since it will help you to avoid mistakes or problems when communicating with fellow natives.

How do I find the complete core lists?

The Internet can offer you tools for exploring products that provide you the core lists. If you plan to attend schools to learn foreign languages, the instructors should provide you with materials that include the core list, dictionary, glossary, etc, if they don't, you are in the wrong class. From this test, you can see that some of the foreign language spoken in German, is the same as it is spoken in English. When you search for online courses, or attend schools the instructors should offer you guides that brings out association and core lists.

In so many schools, translators has mislead students, which began speaking languages and to find out what they learnt was misconstrued and lead to areas of concern. In some instances, miscommunications lead to fights.

The Biological Constraints in Foreign Language Training

so logical question, it has everything to do with learning foreign languages.

When you start learning foreign languages, you will need to use ‘determinants’ to change your behaviors. Clarifying, determinants are factors that ‘cause’ or influence something to happen. We see determinants often in mathematical quizzes, etc, as it is the elements that are used in many processes, such as solving equations simultaneously or studying linear to transform them to numerical values.

Now ask your question again, which by now you should see clearly how biological determinants apply to learning foreign languages, as do genetics, instincts and so on.

Determinants can affect the way we learn. Down through the years, it was evident during many studies that people have constraints in their learning behaviors that often hinder them from learning the same pattern in the same ways. For example, if you were taught how to use a computer and didn’t know anything about computers, the next lesson you would learn something new, yet your behavior patterns would change.

In short, we have to remove these restraints when desiring to learn a foreign language. WE have to see foreign language from all sides, since the sides change grammar, style and structure in a way that it will likely confuse you often if you cannot drop the restraints and show a willingness to listen, learn, write, study, etc. You want to learn how to form a common ground in your behaviors so that it becomes a habit, yet you want to keep your mind open to suggestions that just might lead you to successfully learning a new language.

Most people believe that traditional teaching and instrumental methods can condition the mind to learn effectively. This shows in our biological aspects, since when instruments join with tradition we often see patterns that fit our beliefs. Beliefs is something we become accustomed to in time, and often holds firm in our personality when we believe what we have learned.

Take down this barrier, since you are building road blocks that will hinder you from learning effectively. Beliefs are our stronghold and are good, yet when you have no facts to back those beliefs, they will fall, just as you will fall until you use your instincts, logic and ability to explore to the fullest and reach beyond what you already know.

Learning is better accomplished when we use our abilities to observe and listen. Observing and listening alone will take you to doors you never thought you could open.

Put down those constraints and move forward to foreign language training, since only then will you find learning easier. The constraints within us, often hindering us from learning effectively, since we cannot remove in many instances, the influences that pushed us to believe something that just might not be the truth. I don't want to change the tune and turn religious on you, but let me show you how behaviors are constrained by demonstrating something that has been taught for years. In many religions, they tell us we are going to "hell" if we are bad. This is something religious sectors from

across the lands as taught us for generations, which some do not, but since most do, it is not uncommon to find people that believe this, despite the bible tells us otherwise. See the patterns and how something's you believe may hinder you from learning effectively and finding positive light.

Now that you have an overview of how biological constraints can hinder us, you can begin your journey to learning foreign language. Now, check out the training toys in foreign language training:
